Want to buy a foreclosed home?

If you do, there will be free workshop Saturday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at St. Adalbert's Church, 1923 W. Becher St. in Milwaukee

The workshop will provide step-by-step information on the process for purchasing a foreclosed home, information about affordable loans designed specifically to purchase a foreclosed home, access to down payment and home repair assistance and facts about the first-time buyer federal housing tax credit of up to \$8,000.

The workshop will also highlight the benefits of buying a home in the Layton Boulevard West Neighbors area on the city's south side.
